Dear Alaska House Resources Committee Members,

I've spent the better part of the last 40 years living in the Bering Strait Region. I am seeing dramatic changes that would have been unthinkable just a decade ago.

Nome's shorefast ice, that used to clear out in late May, now disappearing before even the first Iditarod musher arrives.

Hunters in Savoonga with no ice at all, forcing them to travel over 40 miles in small open 18' skiffs in search of game, and then getting caught in dangerous seas without ice to keep the waves from building.

I used to be able to get an airplane to Diomedes that would land on the frozen ice between the two Diomedes islands, from before Christmas until early May - and now they have open water in January! There is NOTHING in their long oral history of anything like this ever happening before.

Each summer whole swaths of willows and now dwarf birch in the tundra around Nome are being stripped of life by repeated and unprecedented insect infestations.

I could go on with more of my own personal observations, from village homes with plywood and visqueen over windows broken by melting permafrost to hummingbirds showing up in my flower beds in Nome.

Alaska is clearly on the forefront of climate change and needs to be a global leader drawing attention to the dramatic changes, and in implementing climate solutions. It is time for our elected officials to step into leadership roles on climate issues. H.R. 12 would help implement a step in the right direction.
