Analysis

This legislation slightly expands the boundaries of the Funter Bay State Marine Park to include the site of the Unanga cemetery, and adds to uncodified law a directive to the Department of Natural Resources that the Funter Bay Marine Park Management Plan be amended to protect the social and historical significance of the cemetery.

The Department does not anticipate any fiscal impact from this legislation.
