FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB 169

Analysis

This legislation requires the Alaska State Council on the Arts (Council) to set an additional fee for vehicle registration plates celebrating AS 28.10.161(b)(1)(C), not to exceed \$50. The fees shall be collected and accounted for separately. Any revenue in excess of cost to the Division of Motor Vehicles may be appropriated to the Council by the legislature. It is unknown what fee the Council will choose, therefore, the department submits an indeterminate fiscal note.
