Senate Bill 177

Bill Summary

An Act related to driving without a license

This is a summary only. Note that this summary should not be considered an authoritative interpretation of the bill and the bill itself is the best statement of its contents.

Section 1: Amends AS 28.15.011(d), to provide consistency with other sections of law (AS 28.15.291) related to criminal penalties for driving illegally.

Section 2: Amends AS 28.15.181(a), to include driving without a license as grounds for the immediate revocation of a driver's license, privilege to drive, or privilege to obtain a license.

Section 3: Amends AS 28.15.291(a), so that driving without a license is a criminal offense unless they have been granted licensure by another jurisdiction or granted exemption.

Section 4: Amends AS 28.15.291(b), to make driving without a license an infraction or class A misdemeanor dependent upon prior convictions.

Section 5: Amends AS 28.23.100(b), so a transportation network company may not allow a driver to accept trip requests through the transportation network company's digital network if the driver has been convicted of driving without a license.

Section 6: Amends the uncodified law of the State of Alaska by adding a new section that clarifies that this Act applies to offenses committed on or after the effective date.
