### Version A to M

#### Page 1

Lines 7 – 8: language was added to include the "National Guard"

Lines 11-12: Version A required "official documentation to be provided within 10 days after the arrival date stated in the military orders."

Version M changed it to the "official document within 10 days of the student's first day of attendance in a school district."

#### Page 2

Lines 1 – 5: "Residence" language was changed:  
(A) The principal dwelling place of an active duty parent  
(B) A temporary billeting facility on a military base; and  
(C) Federal government housing or off-base military housing provided through a public-private venture.

Lines 2 – 3: "Residence" language:  
(2) "residence" means the principal dwelling place of an active duty parent or guardian
