Version A to M

Page 1

language was added to include the "National Guard" Lines 7 – 8:

Lines 11-12: Version A required "official documentation to be provided within 10 days after the arrival date stated in the military orders."

Version M changed it to the "official document within 10 days of the student's first day of attendance in a school district."

Page 2

"Residence" language was changed: Lines 1 - 5:

- (A) The principal dwelling place of an active duty parent
- (B) A temporary billeting facility on a military base; and
- (C) Federal government housing or off-base military housing provided through a publicprivate venture.

"Residence" language: Lines 2 - 3:

(2) "residence" means the principal dwelling place of an active duty parent or guardian
