Dear Representative Story,

You introduced HB 193, a bill to add a second verse to Alaska's state song ("Alaska's Flag"), this legislative session and asked the University of Alaska (UA) Foundation, as holder of the copyright to both the original Alaska's Flag song and the proposed second verse of the song, for 1) a copy of the words to the second verse as copyrighted and 2) its non-objection to the addition of the second verse to Alaska's state song.

A copy of the words to the original sheet music and second verse, as copyrighted, are attached.

The UA Foundation is unaware of any effect on copyright ownership resulting from recognition of the work as the state song with the permission of the copyright holder, and unaware of any legal impediment to appending a verse with the permission of the affected copyright holder. Thus, the UA Foundation has no objection to recognizing Carol Beery Davis' verse as the second verse to Alaska's state song should a bill be enacted to this effect. This nonobjection is conditioned on an amendment to the bill as introduced; Section 2 of the bill should read:

Sec 2. AS44.09.040 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) Any copy of "Alaska's Flag" produced for public use must have the following attribution and notice: "copyright University of Alaska Foundation, non-commercial use permitted, all other rights reserved."

In order to protect the UA Foundation's copyright, no alterations can be made to the original text (e.g., punctuation changes).
