FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB182

Analysis

SB 182 aligns the minimum age to purchase tobacco products, electronic smoking products, or products containing nicotine in Alaska with the federal law. U.S.C. Sec. 387f(d), as amended by PL 116-94 on December 20, 2019, increased the federal minimum smoking age to 21.

There is no significant change to the business licensing program within the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing, so the division does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this legislation.

The Business Licensing section of the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
