- *** Section 1.** AS 17.30.200(o) is amended to read:
- 5 (o) The board shall promptly notify the State Medical Board, the Board of
- Nursing, the Board of Dental Examiners, <u>and</u> the Board of Examiners in Optometry [,
- AND THE BOARD OF VETERINARY EXAMINERS] when a practitioner registers
- 8 with the database under (n) [(o)] of this section.

- 10 (6) "practitioner"
- 11 (A) means a physician, dentist, advanced practice registered
- nurse, optometrist, scientific investigator, or other person licensed, registered,

- or to administer or use in teaching or chemical analysis a controlled substance
