#### **Major Department Accomplishments in 2019**

- Alaska Oil & Gas Conservation Commission successfully transitioned to the Department of Commerce,
  Community, and Economic Development from the Department of Administration. The Commission administered
  the Class II Underground Injection Control Program (UIC) to protect Alaska's underground fresh water and
  received an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) grant for the 2019 program.
- <u>Economic Development</u>'s Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) was embraced in its first year by government, industry partners, economic development organizations, and community partners around the state. During FY2019 the one-year update was completed, including a revised resiliency framework and Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities & Threats (SWOT) analysis.
- Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing developed and launched its first initial online professional licensing applications. Applying online allows people seeking licensure in Alaska to upload documents, communicate in-app with staff, and track whether mandatory submissions from outside sources such as educational institutions or other licensing jurisdictions have been received. 42,900 professional license holders (49%) are now registered for the MY LICENSE online management service.
- <u>Division of Insurance</u> collected \$85 million in premium taxes, penalties and fees. The division was also awarded a Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Market Stabilization Grant in the amount of \$276,900. Funds will be expended to strengthen the private health insurance market in Alaska.
- Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute hosted 19 seafood companies at the ASMI pavilion during the 2019 Seafood Expo Global in Brussels, Belgium. A total of 11 Alaska seafood companies were part of the ASMI "table exhibitor" program and eight companies reserved booth space. Onsite sales for ASMI pavilion exhibitors (booth and table) reached \$112.812.000 and projected annual sales are estimated at \$1.057.300.000.
- Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority paid the State a dividend of \$4.8 million in FY2019, \$10.3 million in FY2020, and declared a dividend of \$14.5 million for FY2021 to the State of Alaska general fund for a total of over \$422 million in dividends to the state since the inception of the dividend program. AIDEA funded \$86.5 million in development project financings in FY2019.
- Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office conducted 403 investigations and 1,033 inspections/walk-throughs on alcohol and marijuana licensed establishments; approved 134 new marijuana licenses, 58 marijuana renewal licenses, and 25 marijuana transfer applications; processed 128 new alcohol license applications, 156 alcohol license transfer applications, 906 alcohol license renewals, and 1,452 alcohol event permits.
- Community and Regional Affairs assisted 246 communities, which included 192 on-site visits and 192 interventions to prevent disruption to essential public services. These interventions included providing 71 fuel loans to communities ineligible for bank loans and coordination of fuel deliveries to avoid critical shortages; Power Cost Equalization (PCE) on-site training and assistance to communities to file and receive payments that would have expired; assistance with filing for Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILT) and Community Assistance Program funds before the application deadline; assistance with critical financial issues involving the Internal Revenue Service; assistance with economic disaster recovery; and reinstatement of insurance coverage. Under the Fuel Watch initiative, staff made 580 calls to 236 entities to verify that there were adequate financial resources and fuel supplies in place for winter. The Grant Section administered 737 grants with an approximate value of \$761 million. Of the 737 grants, 24 were new, totaling \$38.6 million.

#### **Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development**

- <u>Investments</u> provided patient capital to stimulate business development, job creation, and resident ownership through direct state loan origination on 296 loans and pre-qualifications totaling \$33.8 million across ten revolving loan funds.
- Regulatory Commission of Alaska established the Beluga River Unit gas field as a regulatory asset and created a
  rate structure that allowed two electric utilities to earn a return and become gas field producers tying in to
  generation, transmission, and distribution systems.
- Alaska Energy Authority began construction on the project to divert the West Fork Upper Battle Creek into
  Bradley Lake. The diversion will increase the Bradley Lake Hydroelectric Project annual energy by approximately
  37,000 megawatt hours (MWh), increasing output by 10 percent.
- <u>Banking and Securities</u> actively protected consumers by issuing eleven orders and assessing civil penalties.
   Sixty-six cases involved financial exploitation of vulnerable adults. The division anticipates more of these types of cases with the updated Alaska Securities Act which became effective January 2019, and increases the civil penalty for a single violation from \$25,000 to \$100,000.
- <u>Executive Administration</u> increased efficiency in service delivery through the work of the information technology (IT) unit to create electronic document management systems for professional licensing and economic development. IT also created online application processes for the Made in Alaska program, professional licensing, and insurance premium tax payments.

#### **Key Department Challenges**

- Supporting effective local government and essential public services as communities' experience declines in resources available for operations and infrastructure projects;
- Efficiently utilizing a smaller economic development staff to develop the state economy in the face of economic uncertainty and message that Alaska is open for business;
- Efficiently and effectively regulating the marijuana and alcohol industries; and
- Providing energy infrastructure and services at a reasonable cost to Alaska communities.

### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2021

- Renewed focus and cross-departmental collaboration on supporting and promoting Alaska's economic potential.
- Improved service to the rapidly evolving alcohol and marijuana industries.
- Increased partnerships and more efficient support for communities and local governments.
