11	costs of providing drinking water testing and blood testing under AS 46.03.340 unless

13	(c) The liability of a person for costs under this section is in addition to other
14	liability under this chapter, AS 46.08, AS 46.09, or other state law for a release of a
15	perfluoroalkyl substance or polyfluoroalkyl substance.

18	not include a commercial motor vehicle, as defined in AS 28.90.990;
