BILL NO. HB 301

Analysis

HB 301 amends AS 18.62.020-050 to require proof that an applicant for a plumber or electrician certificate of fitness has successfully completed an apprenticeship program approved by the department or equivalent apprenticeship, or verification by an Alaska-based labor union of the applicant's fitness, for a certificate of fitness to issue.

The Division of Employment and Training Services does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
