FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 280

Analysis

The bill creates a 27-member Alaska Invasive Species Council (Council) to facilitate cooperation between local, tribal, state, and federal governments and other organizations and individuals to respond to invasive species. It provides for a variety of tactics and strategies that state agencies might use in such response. It requires the Alaska Department of Fish & Game (ADF&G) to classify all non-native biological material existing in the state, including plants, animals, microbes, etc., as either prohibited, regulated, or approved.

The Council would be given authorization to evaluate non-native species, and to classify them by criteria according how likely they are to take hold or become naturalized in the state, the degree to which their presence would impact human, plant and animal life in the state, ADF&G's ability to control them, or other regulatory criteria.

As nearly every species used in current agricultural production is non-native, and Department of Natural Resources, Division of Agriculture currently has statutory management authority for species utilized in agriculture as well as regulating pest. It is not possible to determine whether the Division of Agriculture's responsibilities would be reduced, expanded, or continue unchanged; therefore, the division submits an indeterminant fiscal note.
