RE: SB 172 Follow-Up Information from the Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions

Dear Co-Chairs von Imhof and Stedman:

Thank you for the opportunity to discuss SB 172 and the extension of the State Medical Board. The committee requested the following information:

- A list of previous board members showing their term dates, if their terms expired, if they resigned, or were removed;
- Why the members with unexpired terms were removed;
- How board members were notified of changes to their appointments and a copy of that correspondence; and
- A list of current board members and their appointment and term expiration dates.

The Governor's Office of Boards and Commissions asked the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing to submit this follow-up response on their behalf.

Per AS 08.64.010 and AS 08.01.035, the State Medical Board is an eight-member board that has a term limit of two full or partial consecutive terms. All members of the State Medical Board serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

When a member reaches the end of service, staff of the governor's office of Boards and Commissions will call members to notify them of the change. A follow up letter from the governor is then sent thanking them for their service (attached).

The Legislative Budget and Audit report dated April 26, 2019, entitled <u>A Sunset Review of the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State Medical Board</u>, showed significant compliance concerns regarding the State Medical Board. The report conclusion states:

- Board actions were inconsistently reported to the FSMB (Federation of State Medical Boards).
- The board did not adopt controlled substance prescription database registration regulations.
- The board did not ensure licensees register with the controlled substance prescription database.

With six of eight seats open for appointment (five seats expired plus one resignation), the governor felt it was the opportune time to take the board in a new direction with the goal of correcting the audit's serious concerns. He is confident that their talents, expertise, and dedication will enable them to get up to speed quickly to carry out their duties of protecting Alaskans. The board has already scheduled training for their members who have spent the past few weeks learning and understanding their roles. The previous board met in February and new appointments to the

board were made in March, which will allow ample time for the members to be ready for their next regularly schedule quarterly meeting in May. The governor takes the public health concerns of COVID-19 and the PDMP issue very seriously, as evidenced in his March 11, 2020, declaration and the timing of the appointees to the State Medical Board.
