STATE OF ALASKA 2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill extends the 30-day declaration of a public health disaster emergency that Governor Dunleavy issued on March 11, 2020 to March 12, 2021, providing:

- Flexibility to certain statutes that will require detailed business and professional licensing requirements;
- Extending deadlines for certain filings;
- Adding standing orders for the Chief Medical Officer; and
- Extending the authority of the director of the Division of Insurance (DOI) when dealing with a disaster, so that the sunset of any order issued by the director mirrors that of the governor's proclamation.

This bill allows the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing (CBPL) to grant licenses to individuals licensed in good standing in other jurisdictions; opens up the ability for medical and nursing professionals to perform telemedicine without a license in this jurisdiction; and allows for expediting of fingerprinting for nursing applicants.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
