Sec. 18.05.020. Department to report activities. The department shall prepare an annual report of its activities and notify the legislature not later than 10 days after it convenes that the report is available. <u>If the department is not able to</u> <u>meet the staffing standards for an adult civil unit in the state psychiatric hospital</u> <u>developed under AS 47.30.660(c), the department shall include in the</u> <u>department's annual report the following information:</u>

(1) the number of employees who vacated positions during the reporting period;
