

Value of Postsecondary Education

- Median earnings jump from:
 - \$35,328 for high school graduates
 - \$44,619 for Alaskans with an associate degree
 - \$57,708 for those with a bachelor's degree
 - \$77,402 for holders of graduate or professional degrees
- Lower unemployment rates
- Provide skills required for new and advancing careers



96.3% of working graduates are Alaska residents


