This legislation would create a new chapter in Title 16 allowing for the creation of shellfish enhancement projects, similar to salmon hatcheries. If enacted, the Commissioner of Fish & Game could issue permits to non-profit corporations seeking to engage in shellfish enhancement activities. The Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission (CFEC) currently issues special harvest area permits to salmon hatcheries, and under the provisions of this bill would issue special harvest area permits to shellfish enhancement enterprises.
