Analysis

The bill adds aquatic farming or related hatchery site leases as described in AS 38.05.083 to the list of leases which the Director of the Division of Mining, Land & Water may renew under AS 38.05.070(e).

A minimal amount of staff time will be needed for meeting annual reporting requirements.
