SENATE BILL 72

Civics Education in Alaska Schools

SECTIONAL ANALYSIS (Version i)

Section 1: <u>AS 14.03.076</u>, relating to public schools, adds a new section

- a. directing the State Board of Education & Early Development (SBOE) to develop curriculum and a related assessment aligned with state standards pertaining to government, citizenship, and include the history of the U.S. federal government, Alaska state government, and Alaska Tribal government; and
- b. requiring students to take the assessment established in (a) above in order to receive a high school diploma, and for schools to document on student transcripts when they have taken the assessment
- Section 2: <u>AS 14.07.168</u>, relating to reporting requirements of the SBOE, to include in their annual report to the legislature a description of civics education curriculum in the state, and of student performance on the assessment described in section 1, by district.
- Section 3: Provides for an effective date of July 1, 2022.
