FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to opioid overdose drugs; and providing for an effective date."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 17.20.085(c) is amended to read:

4 (c) The chief medical officer of the department may issue a standing order,
5 including a statewide standing order, for the prescription of an opioid overdose drug.
6 [A STANDING ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MUST EXPIRE
7 ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2021.]

8 * **Sec. 2.** AS 17.20.085(d) is amended to read:

9 (d) Annually, on or before October 1, the department shall complete a report
10 describing activities and expenditures related to Substance Abuse and Mental Health
11 Services Administration grants and opioid overdose drug distribution [THE
12 OPIOID EPIDEMIC] and shall submit the report to the senate secretary and chief
13 clerk of the house of representatives and notify the legislature that the report is
14 available.

15 * **Sec. 3.** Section 2, ch. 1, SLA 2017, is repealed.

1 * **Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
