- 4 (c) The chief medical officer of the department may issue a standing order,
- including a statewide standing order, for the prescription of an opioid overdose drug. 5

- 7 ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2021.]
- 8 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 17.20.085(d) is amended to read:
- 9 (d) Annually, on or before October 1, the department shall complete a report
- 10 describing activities and expenditures related to Substance Abuse and Mental Health
- Services Administration grants and opioid overdose drug distribution [THE 12 OPIOID EPIDEMIC] and shall submit the report to the senate secretary and chief
- 13 clerk of the house of representatives and notify the legislature that the report is
- 14 available.
