FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 110

Analysis

HB 110 aligns the minimum age in Alaska to purchase tobacco products, electronic smoking products, or products containing nicotine with 21 U.S.C. Sec. 387f(d) as amended by PL 116-94, December 20, 2019.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing (CBPL) does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.

Business licensing at CBPL is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
