Summary of Changes: CSHB 137 ver A to ver G

Page 1, line 5 through page 2, line 4: Deleted all material and insert new Section 1, via Amendment B.1 in House State Affairs Committee. This language clarified the intent of the bill is to require the State of Alaska to continue to operate a public office or partnership in communities of 850 or more that it operated on January 1st, 2021; and provide the same services as of Jan 1st 2021. This ensures continuity of services; many are required by state and federal statute. The loss of critical services would require an in-person visit to state run locations and a driving trip of several hundred miles, which would be a significant burden for commercial and personal vehicle traffic.

This language also does not preclude a private business from opening in any community if they so wished.
