This bill removes the ability to close a State operated Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) office in communities that have 850 or more citizens irrespective of need, economic conditions, demand for services, facility considerations, cost to the state, staffing provisions, technological advances, changes to the industry, or other unforeseen conditions. Passage of the bill would not allow DMV to establish a replacement partner when needed. It is unclear the negative effect that this will have on the DMV in future years because cost savings from transitioning to partnerships and closing a State operated DMV offices would not be available for consideration.
If this bill were enacted and the DMV budget is reduced by future legislatures or administrations the only cost saving alternative available is the elimination of PCNs or reduction in office hours, thereby reducing services offered to Alaskans.
Historically, at the end of the fiscal year, DMV lapses operating funds to the general fund and the effect of this bill will result in a decrease of DMV's contribution to the general fund. This legislation would require DMV to continue operating the six locations proposed to be transitioned to public-private partnerships and would require an increment of \$582.5 and six (6) PCNs compared to the FY2022 Governor's budget.
