FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to voter preregistration for minors at least 16 years of age."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 15.07.040 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
- 4 (b) A person may preregister to vote at any time if the person
- 5 (1) is at least 16 years of age;
- 6 (2) does not yet meet the age requirement to register under (a) of this
- 7 section;
- 8 (3) provides the information required under AS 15.07.060(1) (4), (7)
- 9 (9), (11), and (12) to a registration official or a voter registration agency as required
- 10 under AS 15.07.050(a); and
- 11 (4) otherwise meets the qualifications of a voter in AS 15.05.010(1)
- 12 and (3).
- 13 (c) When a person has preregistered to vote under (b) of this section, the
- division shall, 90 days before the person reaches 18 years of age, register the person to
- vote and forward to the person an acknowledgment in the form of a registration card.
