11	(d) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a court may revoke the
12	sport fishing license of a person who is convicted of violating this section.
13	(e) Information collected under this section is confidential to the extent
14	provided under AS 16.05.815.
15	(f) The board may adopt regulations under AS 44.62 (Administrative
16	Procedure Act) that it considers necessary to implement this section.
17	(g) In this section, "salt water sport fishing guide services" means assistance,
18	for compensation or with the intent to receive compensation, to a sport fisherman to
19	take or to attempt to take fish by accompanying or physically directing the sport
20	fisherman in sport fishing activities on salt water during any part of a sport fishing
21	trip; "salt water sport fishing guide services" does not include
22	(1) sport fishing services; or
23	(2) services provided by an assistant, deckhand, or similar person who
24	works directly under the supervision of and on the same vessel as a person providing
25	salt water sport fishing guide services.
26	(h) A person who knowingly fails to comply with a requirement for timely
27	submission of reports required by a regulation adopted under this section is guilty of a
28	(1) violation for the first offense; or
29	(2) class B misdemeanor for the second or subsequent offense in a
30	three-year period.
31	(i) Under circumstances not proscribed under (h) of this section, a person who
