**1. Provide a list of Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses offered by school districts.**

The Department of Education and Early Development's (DEED) CTE Portal has a list of all approved school district CTE courses and it's available at the following link:

Enclosed is a spreadsheet that contains courses and sequences by school district that students actually enrolled in for the past two school years (2018-2019 and 2019-2020). Actual enrollments for the current school year will not be available until December 2021.
