FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB22

Analysis

This legislation repeals the sunset on the intensive management (IM) surcharge in § 33, ch. 18 SLA 2016. This proposal does not have any additional cost to the department. Should the surcharge sunset in December of 2022, the department will see a significant decrease in revenue to pay for wildlife research and management. Change in revenue reflects the repeal date which begins in the middle of FY2023, and full surcharge collection will begin in FY2024.

Revenue from the IM surcharge totaled approximately \$1 million in each of the last three calendar years (CY2018, CY2019, and CY2020). Most of those funds are used to match federal Pittman-Robertson dollars at a 1:3 ratio.
