FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to proposing and enacting laws by initiative."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 15.45.240 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 4 (b) The provisions of an initiative are not severable after being circulated 5 under AS 15.45.110. An initiative petition may not contain a severability clause. If a 6 court finds a provision of an initiative petition unconstitutional during a review under 7 (a) of this section, the court shall order the lieutenant governor to reject the entire 8 initiative petition and prohibit the placement of the initiative on the ballot.
