The Alaska Pharmacists Association (AKPhA) represents nearly 250 pharmacists and technicians statewide. Our members work front-line to provide COVID-19 testing and vaccinations among many other services to improve the health of Alaskans.

AKPhA would like to express our support for HB76 and the extension of the COVID-19 Disaster Declaration. The Disaster Declaration supported Alaska pharmacies, pharmacists, and technicians in a number of ways. These include bringing federal financial support and assistance into Alaska to support our businesses and healthcare providers, providing regulatory flexibility to ensure maximum access to safe care, allowing expanded telehealth capabilities, and ensuring payment for some pharmacy-provided services including COVID testing and vaccinations.

The pandemic continues to impact the physical, mental, and financial well-being of Alaskans.
