BILL NO. SB 11

Analysis

Senate Bill 11 modifies the community property law to explicitly provide that the income generated by, and the appreciation of, a community property trust are themselves community property.

This change is not expected to have any operational or fiscal impact on the court system, which therefore submits this zero fiscal note.
