| This legislation will extend the declaration of a public health emergency for the State of Alaska to March 15, 2021 or until the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) Commissioner certifies to the Governor that there is no longer a present outbreak of novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19). |

| This legislation allows the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing (CBPL) to grant license to individuals licensed in good standing in other jurisdictions; extends the ability for medical and nursing professionals to perform telemedicine without a license in this jurisdiction; and allows for expediting of fingerprinting for nursing applicants. It also extends the ability for corporation shareholders and nonprofit members to meet electronically. |
| CBPL does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation. |
| Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs. |
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
