14	AS 15.20.064, and for 24 hours after the time the polls open on election day. From 24
15	hours after the polls open until all election results are certified under AS 15.15.450
16	the director shall ensure an election official is continuously available to respond to
17	calls made to the hotline.
18	(b) The director shall have the election offense hotline number printed on a
19	sticker and placed on voting machines, ballot envelopes, and other election materials
20	in a manner the director determines will provide maximum public notice of the
21	election offense hotline established under (a) of this section.
