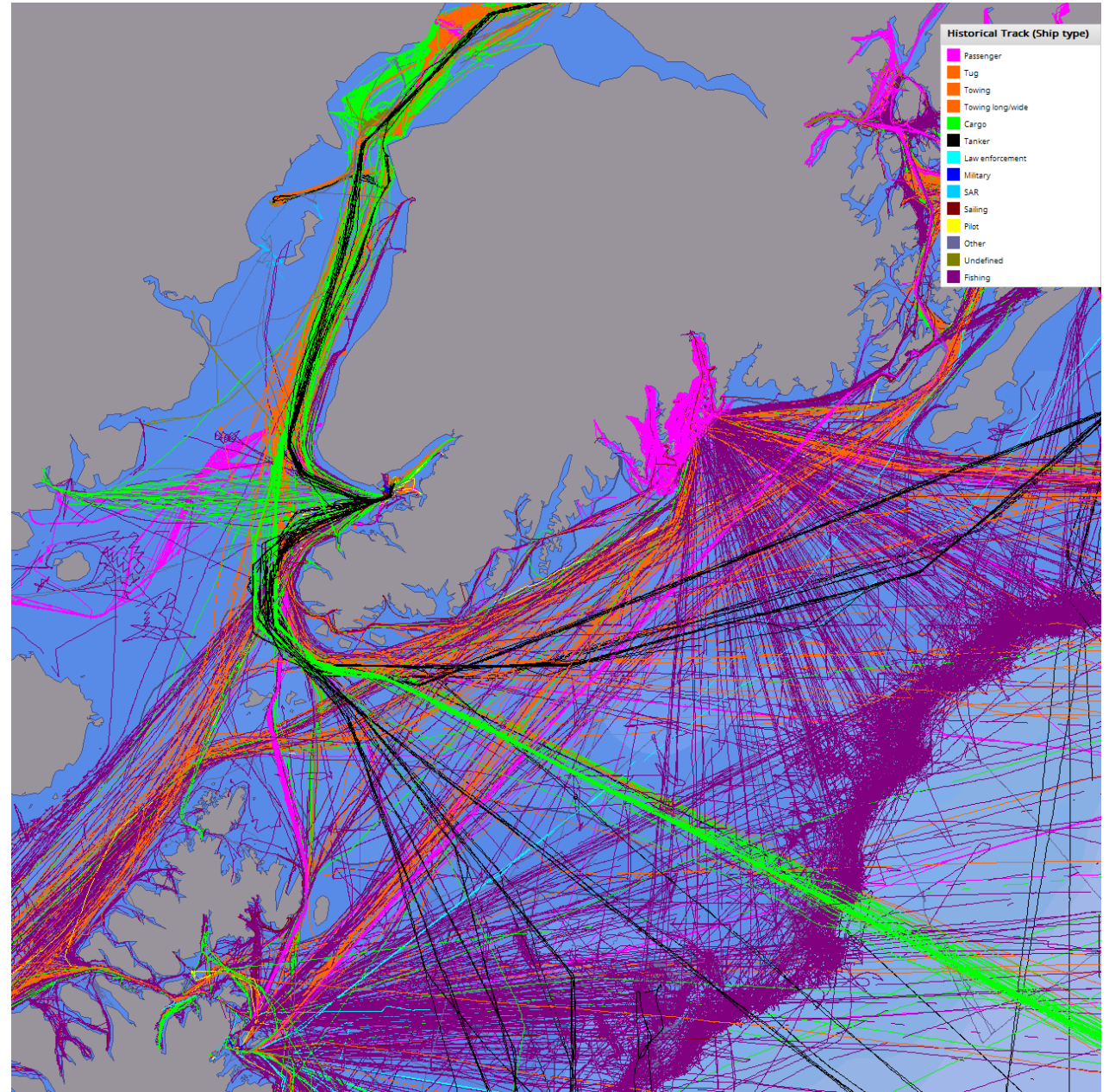

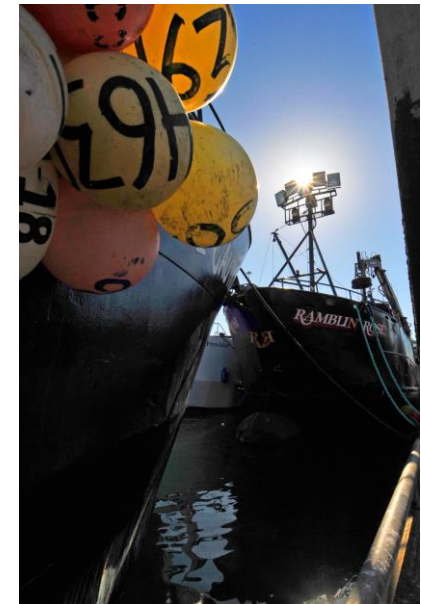
Shipping Routes and Homer

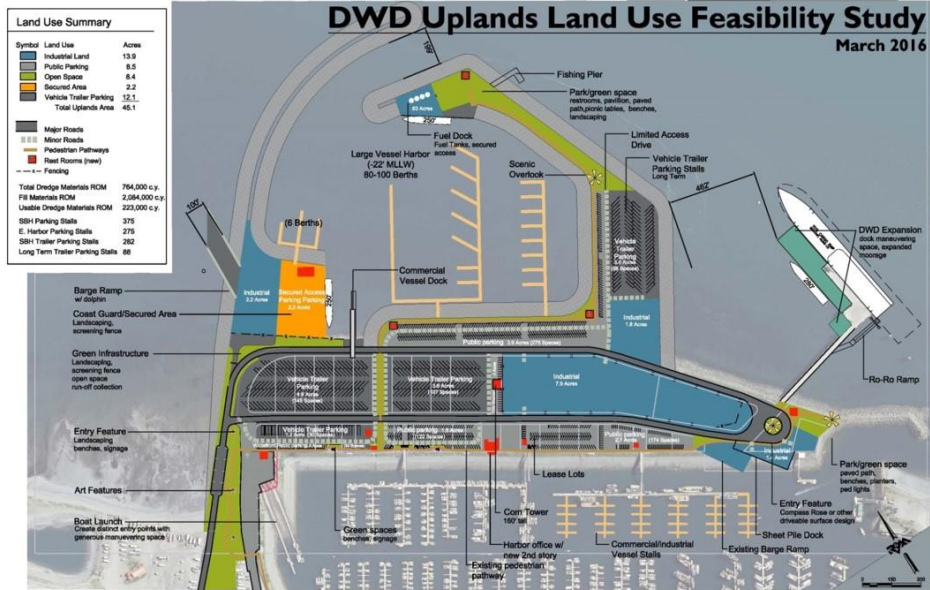

Homer's Large Vessel Port Expansion and what it means for Transportation

ICE FREE PORT

Overwintering of vessels now traveling to the lower 48 means efficiency, less travel, and lower overhead costs for shipping/cargo .

TRANSPORTATION HUB

Homer (Kachemak Bay) is designated as the Port of Refuge for Cook Inlet and Anchorage bound vessels, as well as vessels throughout

WATER, ROAD, & AIR

Homer is connected by land, sea and air, Sterling Hwy, the AK Marine Hwy, and Homer Airport 6700' runway.

EMERGENCY CONTINGENCY

Homer's deep water dock and port expansion has been identified as a contingency plan to the Port of Alaska .

ARCTIC SUPPORT

As the Arctic continues to open up, shipping/cargo and vessel support needs are expected to continue to increase.
