We strongly support SB101. We also strongly support adequate funding for staff and operational costs of CACFA.

Historically CACFA provided a public forum for Alaskans' observations on whether ANILCA provisions accommodating their needs were being conscientiously administered by federal agencies. Detailed records confirm that in many cases they are not — whether through ignorance of the law, agencies' self-serving interpretations, or carelessness.

CACFA historically reviewed citizen's concerns, investigated them, and recommended remedies for actual problems. It has served a unique role not fulfilled by government agencies. The public and state agencies need all the help they can get in wading through the complexities of ANILCA. They need it now — and they'll continue to need it in the future.
