SECTIONAL ANALYSIS FOR SB 47

"An Act relating to special registration plates for vehicles owned by persons with disabilities."

Section 1: Amends AS 28.10.181(d) to include disabled veterans, persons disabled in the line of duty serving in the Alaska Territorial Guard, other persons with disabilities, and upon request persons with disability that limits or impairs ability to walk as defined in 23 C.F.R. 1235.2. Under the amended AS 28.10.181(d) qualified persons shall be able to register their motor vehicle in the name of the person without charge, issued a registration plate that recognizes the international symbol of accessibility, and recognition that the applicant is a disabled veteran. Amends AS 28.10.181(d) that special registration plates may be provided by a person licensed as a speech-language pathologist under AS 08.11, as a chiropractor under AS 08.20, as a physician or physician assistant under AS 08.64, [OR] as an advanced practice registered nurse under AS 08.68, or as a physical therapist or occupational therapist under AS 08.84.
