FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

The bill extends the January 15, 2021 Declaration of a Public Health Disaster Emergency to September 30, 2021.

Due to multiple unknown factors, such as the number of militia members called into State Active Duty status, and expenditures associated with this disaster, the Department is unable to calculate the estimated fiscal impact to the State and therefore submits an indeterminate fiscal note.

Currently, the Department is operating under the 32 USC 502(f)(2) which is active until March of 2021. Any use of the National Guard after that timeframe would need to be considered by the State due to the need to activate Guard members under AS 26.05.070.
