Analysis

This bill suspends the background check requirements for hospitals and skilled nursing facilities until July 1, 2022. Revenue impacts to the division are indeterminate. If the suspension is maintained through the entirety of fiscal year 2022 estimated forgone revenue could be as high as \$192,000, based on the assumption of approximately 4,800 applications for which revenue will not be received in FY2022.

The Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) Background Check Unit charges \$88.25 per application. The DHSS background check application processing fee is \$40 and the Department of Public Safety (DPS) fee to process the fingerprints is \$48.25 totaling the \$88.25 per application charge. DPS' portion of the \$48.25 includes \$35 State fee, plus \$13.25 fee for FBI background check paid directly to the FBI with the state retaining \$2 of the FBI fee for processing costs.
