FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 3006

Analysis

This bill suspends the requirement for hospitals and nursing facilities to seek background checks from the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) until July 1, 2022.

Under AS 47.05.300 – 390 and 7 AAC 10.900 – 990, any person working as an employee or volunteer of a hospital as defined under AS 47.32.900(14), or nursing facility as defined under AS 47.32.900(18), is subject to a fingerprint-based criminal history background check. This includes a check of both state criminal history records through the Alaska Public Safety Information Network (APSIN) and national criminal history records through the Federal Bureau of Investiation (FBI).

DHSS provides interagency receipts to the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Division of Statewide Services (DSS), for the processing of these background checks. The cost per background check is \$48.25 which includes the state fee of \$35.00 and the FBI fee of \$13.25. DPS retains the state fee as well as \$2.00 of the FBI fee for a total of \$37.00 per background check. The FBI allows DPS to retain \$2.00 of their fee for administrative purposes and bills DPS \$11.25 for each national criminal history record check.

Should this bill pass, the revenue impacts to DSS are indeterminate. Assuming the suspension is maintained through the entirety of FY2022, the estimated foregone revenue could be as high as \$177,600.
