"The legislature shall by general law establish and maintain a system of public school open to all children for the state..."



Rates by annual income level


- \$25 per year for those with annual income less than \$30,000
- \$100 per year for workers with annual income \$30,000-\$59,999

- \$200 per year for workers with income \$60,000-\$89,999
- \$400 per year for workers with income \$90,000-\$119,999
- \$600 per year for workers with income over \$120,000

FY23 - \$64 million
FY24 - \$64 million
FY25 - \$65 million
FY26 - \$65 million
FY27 - \$65 million
