Dear Chair Spohnholz,

Two questions were raised in the October 28<sup>th</sup> House Ways and Means Meeting which were deferred to a follow-up response.

1. Can we get the nominal value of the Base Student Allocation (BSA) over time compared with that value adjusted for inflation? What would the BSA be today if adjusted for inflation?

In nominal terms, the BSA increased from FY15-FY17 and remained flat in FY18-FY22. Overall, it has decreased in real terms. If the BSA were to grow from FY15 to FY22 at the rate of inflation, the FY22 BSA would be \$6,355. If the BSA were to grow at 2% per year from FY15-FY22, the FY22 BSA would be \$6,696.

This table shows historical BSA amounts in nominal and real terms.

Additional funding to school districts was also provided outside of the formula in the following years and amounts: FY15 - \$43 million, FY19 - \$20 million, and FY20 - \$30 million.

## 2. How can school districts spend foundation formula funding?

Foundation formula funding is discretionary and can be spent by school districts for any education purpose. This includes instructional and non-instructional functions and a

wide range of costs such as: salaries and benefits, administrative, maintenance, technology, contractual, utilities, insurance, supplies, and equipment costs.

Revenue (including foundation formula revenue) in the operating fund is co-mingled with other sources and can be transferred to other funds, such as the Student Transportation Fund, the Food Services Fund, or the Capital Projects Fund, as needed.
