FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to political contribution limits; and providing for an effective date."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * **Section 1.** AS 15.13.070(b) is repealed and reenacted to read: 4 (b) An individual may contribute to a 5 (1) candidate for the following offices an amount not to exceed: 6 (A) \$1,500 a year, if the election is for governor or lieutenant 7 governor; 8 (B) \$1,000 a year, if the election is for the state senate; 9 (C) \$700 a year, if the election is for the state house of 10 representatives; (D) \$700 a year, if the election is for a 11 12 (i) delegate to a constitutional convention; 13 (ii) judge seeking retention; or 14 (iii) municipal office; 15 (2) nongroup entity for the purpose of influencing the nomination or

1	election of a candidate, an amount not to exceed \$1,000 a year,
2	(3) group that is not a political party, an amount not to exceed \$1,000 a
3	year; and
