Analysis

This bill would direct the Department of Labor and Workforce Development (DOLWD) to verify an unemployment insurance claimant's identity on initial determination with the Department of Health and determine whether or not the claim was submitted from a duplicate, out-of-state, or foreign internet protocol address if pertinent to redetermination.

This indeterminate fiscal note reflects the need for more input from DOLWD and the department's information technology team regarding potential impacts. The division does not know the impact and systems changes needed to facilitate the proposed legislation, but if the departments involved have access to systems and only need to modify an existing agreement to share information legally, it would be a zero fiscal note.
