## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

## STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

## **Analysis**

This bill amends AS 12.62.400(a) to authorize a fingerprint submission to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for a state and national criminal history check for employment as a Village Public Safety Officer (VPSO) under AS 18.65.672 or certification as a VPSO under AS 18.65.682. It also amends AS 18.65.080 by adding a new subsection for DPS to investigate an individual who applies for employment as a VPSO under AS 18.65.672, or certification as a VPSO under AS 18.65.682, to determine whether the individual has been convicted of a disqualifying crime under AS 18.65.672(b).
This bill will increase the number of entities potentially submitting requests for fingerprint-based background checks to DPS. Receipt of state and national criminal history information requires the receiving entity to comply with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Security Policy which requires physical and logical security measures, biennial training, and auditing the agency for compliance to the policy. DPS is required to provide training and conduct biennail audits to ensure compliance to the FBI CJIS Security Policy and federal and state laws.
Given there are currently ten VPSO employing organizations, DPS anticipates being able to absorb these additional duties with existing staffing and resources. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
