The AOEETT manages a federally registered apprenticeship program, which places as many as 140+ operators, mechanics, and service oilers annually throughout the State of Alaska. Our apprentices are often employed by the largest civil construction companies in the state.



We service 1500 – 1800 IUOE Local 302 members annually with safety, skills upgrade, and certifications required to work in the state of Alaska.



- \$3.5 Billion for Rural Sanitation (natl.)

- \$700+ Million currently awarded and upcoming for highway improvements. (2021&2022)



Cost

Budget = \$3.5 - \$4 Million annually Labor = +-\$2 Million Fuel/Maintenance = \$300K Expenses = \$1 - \$1.5 Million Expansion = \$2.3 Million New Equipment = \$175K annually
