FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA

BILL NO. SB 192

Analysis

SB 192 amends the statutes governing the practice of midwifery to align with national safety and education standards.

The bill extends the licenses of midwives and apprentices who hold an Alaska license on December 31, 2022, for an additional two years. During this time period renewal fees will not be collected, which will result in a decrease in revenues collected. A general fund appropriation of \$100.8 will be required to offset the foregone revenue of one renewal period and the cost of new regulations to ensure the program does not go into deficit as a result of this legislation.

If the bill passes the following expenses will be incurred:

Services: \$2.3 in FY2022 for legal costs to amend regulations, printing, and postage

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are primarily funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
