Dear Senators Shower, Reinbold, Costello, Holland and Kawasaki,

I support the passage of HB 234, re-establishing campaign contribution limits in Alaska.

I am familiar with the reasoning of at least some of the APOC commissioners in their decision not to unilaterally set campaign contribution. The commissioners felt that this action should be in the wheelhouse of the legislature, and that as un-elected officials, APOC commissioners should not be the authority setting these limits. This does not mean that APOC opposes the idea of campaign contribution limits. Rather, they remanded the problem to the legislature as the appropriate authority to set those limits.

Inaction on the part of the Senate State Affairs Committee defeats the purpose of the APOC commissioners in their decision, and dishonors that decision. I encourage you to move this bill to the full Senate for passage.

I have been an active donor to Democratic and Centrist candidates in recent years, and have often been APOC limited in those donations, which I consider to be fair.
