STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 406

Analysis

This legislation would require the hiring of 15 Recorder 2 positions, additional leased office space and considerations for other core cost expenditures. It would require every deed presented for recording to be manually reviewed prior to recording and compared against said Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons List published by the United States Department of the Treasury, Office of Foreign Assets.

This bill would not result in an increase to revenue, resulting in need of UGF.

<u>Recorder positions located in Anchorage:</u> Fifteen Permanent Full-Time GGU, Recorder 2, R13 positions.
