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## The HIPAA Privacy Rule

The HIPAA Privacy Rule establishes national standards to protect individuals' r individually identifiable health information (collectively defined as "protected he applies to health plans, health care clearinghouses, and those health care provide health care transactions electronically. The Rule requires appropriate safeguar protected health information and sets limits and conditions on the uses and dis of such information without an individual's authorization. The Rule also gives in protected health information, including rights to examine and obtain a copy of the direct a covered entity to transmit to a third party an electronic copy of their propagate and electronic health record, and to request corrections.
